

THE BIGGEST ORDER FOR JÖST[®] IN COMPANY HISTORY

Investment at German headquarter will be up to Mio. € 4 in 2008.

The internationally operating JÖST[®] group with its headquarter in Dülmen-Buldern, Northrhine-Westfalia has been awarded their biggest order in company history. A leading German producer of non-ferrous heavy metals located in Southern Germany has ordered a turnkey transport and charging system based on vibrating technology to handle brass swarfs, scrap and alloy material for a total value of about Mio € 5.

The whole system will be erected by Jöst specialists and ready for production by the middle of 2010. According to the JÖST[®] management this project shows significantly that the company has reached a successful position in the market regarding sophisticated processing machines and systems. It also emphasizes the market leader's still expanding position in vibratory technology.

This company development is backed up by continuous investments to strengthen the workshop facilities in Dülmen-Buldern, say Dr. Hans Moormann and Christian Fuchs, both joint owners and managing directors of the Jöst group. Currently a high tech sand blasting and painting system is being installed. JÖST[®] will invest an overall of up to Mio. € 4 in 2008.
